Though known for his skills as an artist, Guillaume Singelin is also a master of storytelling, a field where the influence of filmmaking is always present in his work. He has also worked as a designer on a number of video games. He is a permanent member of Label 619 for which he illustrated Loba Loca (a spin-off of Mutafukaz), The Grocery, and P.T.S.D., as well as short stories in Doggybags and LowReader.

RUN, the writer of *Mutafukaz*, gives artist Jérémie Labsolu free rein to step into the universe of his successful series. The misadventures of the *Mutafukaz* heroes are revisited and revised through an introspective story that blends dreams and reality.



Jérémie Labsolu worked for several years at the Bastille Opera in Paris before moving into comic books. Impressed by his artwork, in 2008 RUN asked him to create a spin-off of his *Muthafukaz* series. Alongside this he created the Nana Huxe series for Ankama.

With a National Diploma in Fine Arts and a National Diploma in Art and Techniques, RUN worked as editorial director at Ankama before putting all his focus into his own titles and Label 619 which he created in 2008.
